

Dr. Mohammad Wasiullah (Wasi) Khan, a Pakistani American, is the Chancellor of East-West University. Dr. Khan along with others established the University in 1980 and was its original founder. Today, East-West University, a non-profit, private institution of higher learning offers duly accredited Bachelor's and Associate degree programs in seven academic areas. Thousands of students have graduated from East-West with last year being the 38<sup>th</sup> graduating class.

Previously, Dr. Khan was an educational researcher in Indiana and became Academic Dean in a minority college in Chicago. Earlier he was a teacher and administrator in Pakistan before he arrived in Berkeley, California in 1971. Dr. Khan received his M.A. and M.Ed. Honors degrees from Punjab University, Pakistan, and his Ph.D. in Educational Administration from Indiana University. Throughout his career, Dr. Khan has published many articles and books.
